5 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

6 A. My name is Douglas S. Loreen. My business address is 355 110th Avenue NE,  
7 Bellevue, WA 98004.

8 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

9 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Director Safety & Corporate  
10 Shared Services.

11 **Q. What are your duties as Director of Safety and Corporate Shared Services of**  
12 **PSE?**

13 A. As Director Safety & Corporate Shared Services, I am responsible for Corporate  
14 Safety, Corporate Security, Business Continuity, Facility Services, and Fleet  
15 Services.

16 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

17 A. I earned a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering with honors from  
18 Washington State University in 1985. Following graduation, I worked for a year  
19 at City of Tacoma – Light Division as a Power Supply Engineer. I joined PSE in  
20 June 1986, and I have been employed here continuously since that time. I have  
21 held various staff and management positions in power supply planning,

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engineering, project management, energy efficiency, and environmental services.  
Since being appointed as a Director, I have served as Director Generation Asset Services from October 2007 through May 2011, Director Project Delivery from June 2011 through August 2016, and my current position - Direct Safety & Corporate Shared Services since September 2016. My responsibilities expanded significantly in April 2018 when I took on the Fleet Services and Facilities Services departments due to a retirement.

I have previously sponsored testimony before this Commission covering the capital projects related to the FERC license implementations for the Snoqualmie and Baker River Hydroelectric Projects.
