PUBLIC COUNSEL RESPONSE TO CLUTTER, INC.'S MOTION TO EXTEND EXEMPTION DATE IN ORDER 01

Attorney General's Office ("Public Counsel") responds to Clutter, Inc.'s ("Clutter") Motion for to Extend Exemption Date in Order 01,¹ filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") on April 20, 2022. Clutter seeks an extension of exemptions from certain provisions of Chapter 480-15 Washington Administrative Code (WAC) and Tariff 15-C that are set to expire on May 1, 2022. The Commission previously granted these exemptions in Order 01 in this proceeding.² Clutter requests the Commission extend the exemptions "until the earlier of: 1) December 31, 2022, 2) the date Commission ends the investigation into Tariff 15-C changes, or 3) the effective date of new rules or amendments to Tariff 15-C."³

In principle, Public Counsel does not oppose an extension of the exemptions. The discussions regarding modifications to Tariff 15-C are ongoing, and it would be against the public interest to remove the exemptions at this time only to modify the same provisions in the

near future. Public Counsel notes, however, that WAC 480-07-385(4) states the Commission will grant continuances only to a specified date. Public Counsel therefore recommends that the Commission either grant the continuance until December 31, 2022, with an option for Clutter to seek further continuances if necessary, or explicitly waive the requirement for a date certain and grant either of the other requested options.
