- 8. SUBSEQUENT CUSTOMERS - Additional Customers may be served from a Primary Service Line, provided operating rights can be acquired for extensions thereto. If such additional Customer(s) are connected within three years following the completion of construction of the Primary Service Line, it shall be deemed to have become a line extension and the Company will redetermine the cost thereof in accordance with provisions of Schedule 85 of this tariff.
