Attached is Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE's") Exhibit 5: 2018-2019 Prescriptive Measures, pertaining to PSE's Energy Efficiency programs. This filing is consistent with requirements outlined in condition (5) in Attachment A of Order 01 in Docket UE-171087.

Exhibit 5 is created from an extract of prescriptive (or "deemed": both Regional Technical Forum ("RTF") Unit Energy Savings and PSE Deemed) measures, archived in PSE's conservation project management system, DSMc. Due to the timing of Conservation Plan filings, measure records for the subsequent planning year¹ are unavailable until they are archived in the database for the current program year. Exhibit 5 represents those prescriptive savings values that are now available for applicable Energy Efficiency programs in the current biennium, and will be updated following PSE's filing of its 2019 Annual Conservation Plan.

Consistent with WAC 480-109-110(3), PSE provided an electronic version of Exhibit 5 to its Conservation Resource Advisory Group ("CRAG") on April 25, 2018.
