
This letter is in response to the WUTC's Compliance Review which was completed on Jan 10, 2019. I have reviewed the violations noted and acted to resolve them to the best of my ability. Since the safety investigation results were reported to me, I took the following steps to resolve the violations:

1. Beginning on 1/11/2019 I have documented my time records using the Driver Time Record template.
2. On 1/14/2019 I updated the USDOT filing.
3. On 1/17/2019 I completed the Employee Application for myself and added it to the driver record file.
4. On 1/12/2019 I completed a road test certification and added it to my driver record file.
5. On 1/11/2019 I verified the medical examiner's status on the USDOT website (reprinted on 2/14 to add to the driver file).
6. On 2/7/2019 I had the truck inspected at Mac Truck Repair. Parts have been ordered to resolve the cracked mirror and loose gas tank strap and it will be repaired and re-inspected on 2/23/2019.

Please find additional documentation attached.

I appreciate your consideration of the efforts I am making to turn these compliance issues around and maintain my status with the UTC.

1. 395.8(a)(1), Violation description: Failing to require a driver to prepare a record of duty status using the appropriate method.
  - a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. Our method of tracking hours was not sufficient as it didn't include ending time and hours worked.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. I am now using the Driver Time Record provided in the "Achieving a Satisfactory Motor Carrier Safety Record" provided by Francine on January 10<sup>th</sup>.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. Driver Time Record log sheets are kept in truck to ensure they are available and kept up to date.
  
2. 390.19(b)(2), Violation description: Failing to file the appropriate form under 390.10(a) (MCS-150) each 24 months according to schedule.
  - a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. I filed the USDOT number in 2013 and since there's no expiration date that shows on the FMCSA website I wasn't aware it needed to be renewed every 24 months.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. I have submitted the MCS-150 form.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I created a calendar of relevant dates to track and send notifications of important business dates. This includes renewing the USDOT number every 24 months by February 20.
  
3. 391.21(a), Violation description: Using a driver who has not completed and furnished an employment application.
  - a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. As a sole proprietor I didn't know having this for myself was necessary.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. The application for employment has been completed and added to the employee file.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I now have a copy of the driver qualification file checklist from "Achieving a Satisfactory Motor Carrier Safety Record" in the driver file to ensure all documents are present.
  
4. 391.51(b)(3), Violation description: Failing to maintain road test certificate in driver's qualification file, or copy of license or certificate the motor carrier accepted as equivalent.
  - a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. As a sole proprietor I didn't know having this for myself was necessary.

- b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. The road test certificate has been completed and added to the employee file.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I now have a copy of the driver qualification file checklist from "Achieving a Satisfactory Motor Carrier Safety Record" in the driver file to ensure all documents are present.
5. 391.51(b)(9), Violation description: Failing to place a note related to the verification of the medical examiner's listing on the National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners in driver qualification file.
- a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. I had chosen the medical examiner from the USDOT website so I was confident that the doctor was certified. I did not include this information in the file with the medical exam results.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. I looked up the doctor on the website and printed his credentials including this national registry number. I added a hand-written note that the credentials had been verified.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I now have a copy of the driver qualification file checklist from "Achieving a Satisfactory Motor Carrier Safety Record" in the driver file to ensure all documents are present.
6. WAC 480-15-180, Violation description: Carrier provided operations that require a household goods permit while permit was cancelled.
- a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. During the time the permit was suspended I was working closely with the UTC and since the suspension was due to the insurance company not providing documents even though I had the insurance in place and the permit renewal was pending, I completed the jobs that I had already committed to. I did not post any advertisements or accept new jobs during the time the permit was suspended.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. I renewed the permit as quickly as possible.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I don't intend to jeopardize the permit again and will avoid this situation all together moving forward.
7. 396.9(d)(2), Violation description: Failure to correct violations or defects listed on a motor vehicle roadside inspection report.
- a. Why did this violation occur?

- i. The backup light was reported as defective, replaced, and again became inoperable as the underlying issue was actually related to the wiring.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. I have resolved this issue permanently by addressing the issue with the wiring.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I created a calendar of relevant dates to track and send notifications of important business dates. This includes vehicle maintenance at least every 3 months. Defects that are found in daily inspection will be resolved in a timely manner.
- 8. 396.17(a), Violation description: Using a commercial motor vehicle not periodically inspected.
  - a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. The vehicle has had regular maintenance and general inspections by a mechanic but I did not have a more official fleet maintenance schedule in place.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. I contacted Mac Truck Service in Redmond to perform an inspection on the vehicle.
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I created a calendar of relevant dates to track and send notifications of important business dates. This includes an annual vehicle inspection.
- 9. 396.19(b), Violation description: Failing to maintain evidence of inspector's qualifications.
  - a. Why did this violation occur?
    - i. I did not have the inspector's qualifications on file.
  - b. What actions were taken to correct the violation?
    - i. I requested the mechanic who did the inspection to provide the qualifications document as per "Achieving a Satisfactory Motor Carrier Safety Record".
  - c. What management systems have been put into place to prevent reoccurrence in the future?
    - i. I created a calendar of relevant dates to track and send notifications of important business dates. This includes an annual vehicle inspection which will include getting a copy of the inspector's qualifications.



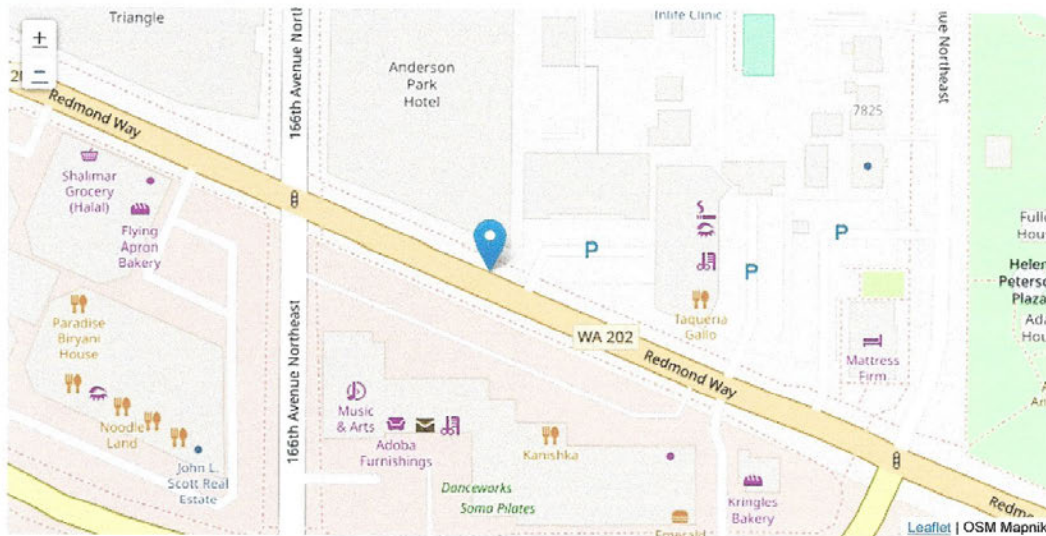
