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RE: Docket UE-231031 Puget Sound Energy's Electric Tariff Revision

The request to extend the current net metering tariff until at least 25 December 2025 is important to maintain the stability of the distributed solar industry that our employees and customers participate in. It allows predictability for all stakeholders in the solar industry while potential replacements of the existing net metering tariff are studied.

Frederickson Electric appreciates PSE's responsible and collaborative approach to the issue of net metering, recognizing that RCW 80.60 establishes a minimum obligation rather than a limit on net metering. Puget Sound Energy's cooperation with other utilities and solar industry stakeholders that are supporting a thorough study on the Value of Distributed Solar and Storage is commendable, and we urge the UTC to quickly approve this tariff request.
