Dear Ms. Washburn:

On behalf of Door-to-Door Storage, Inc. and Shurgard Storage To Go, Inc., this is to indicate acceptance of the revised definitional language at WAC 480-15-020 (14). While maintaining the containerized household goods exception which is critical to the parties I represent, the proposed rule (which flowed out of the stakeholder meeting on December 9, 1999) is a compromise our clients can accept. The March 10, 2000 discussion draft definition of household goods clearly narrows the scope of the exemption, but continues the long-adhered to rule exclusion upon which these innovative businesses were launched in intrastate Washington state service. We continue to be actively engaged in this rulemaking and look forward to working with the staff and other interested parties to finalize the proposed rules for eventual adoption.
