**NOTICE GRANTING SECOND REQUEST  
TO EXTEND FILING DEADLINE  
(Deadline Extended from June 14, 2007 to June 21, 2007)**

TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

On June 12, 2007, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) received a joint request to extend the deadline for filing initial testimony on wire center issues from Qwest Corporation (Qwest) and Eschelon, Inc., (Eschelon). The parties requested that the deadline be extended from June 14, 2007, to June 21, 2007, because the parties are discussing procedure addressing the wire center issues that may eliminate the need for supplemental testimony on this issue. No other deadline would be affected by this request.

According to WAC 480-07-385(2), the Commission will grant a continuance if the requesting party demonstrates good cause for the continuance and the continuance will not prejudice any party or the Commission. The parties stated good cause for the continuance; attempting to resolve the wire center issues by a method that would obviate the need to file supplemental testimony. Granting the continuance should not prejudice any party or the Commission. The extension does not alter any other deadlines in this proceeding. Accordingly, the request should be granted.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That the deadline for filing simultaneous initial testimony on wire centers issues is extended from June 14, 2007, to June 21, 2007.**
