TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On November 19, 2019, Puget Sound Pilots (PSP) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its initial proposed tariff. On November 21, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01, suspending the tariff filing and setting the matter for adjudication. On December 17, the Commission entered Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing, which established a procedural schedule that was later modified by Order 04.

On June 25, 2020, PSP filed a Motion in Limine/Motion to Strike to Exclude Unqualified Expert Testimony (Motion).

WAC 480-07-375 provides that a party that opposes a written motion may file a response within five business days or at such other time as the presiding officer may set. Due to the reduction in staff hours caused by mandatory furloughs and the length and complexity of the Motion, the Commission finds good cause to provide the parties with two additional business days to respond to the Motion. Accordingly, responses must be filed by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, July 8, 2020.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That parties may file a response to Puget Sound Pilots' Motion to Strike by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, July 8, 2020.
