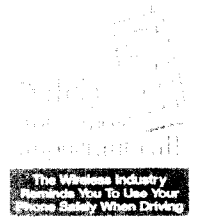

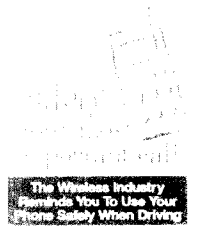

DECLARATION CERTIFYING ABILITY TO FUNCTION IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

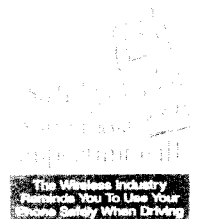
