AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc.; AT&T Local Services on behalf of TCG Seattle; and TCG Oregon (collectively the "AT&T") hereby submit this Motion for an Order Accepting AT&T's Restated Responses to the Questions Posed in Order No. 6. As grounds therefore, AT&T states as follows:

AT&T received the inquiries sought in Order No. 6, and promptly delivered such inquiries to those internal personnel responsible for responding. Shortly thereafter, AT&T received word from Staff of the Commission that it was interested in obtaining responses to Order No. 6 only in relation to "analog" services. Not knowing precisely how Staff was distinguishing "analog" services from "digital" services, AT&T attempted to comply by offering information related to all its services.<sup>1</sup>

It currently appears that AT&T may not have met the desire of Staff or provided Staff with the information necessary for it to accurately distinguish between AT&T's "analog" services from its "digital" services. Consequently, AT&T seeks the opportunity to restate its responses to the inquiries contained in Order No. 6.
