5 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

6 A. My name is Colin P. Crowley, and my business address is Puget Sound Energy, 6  
7 P.O. Box 97034, Bellevue, Washington 98009-9734.

8 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

9 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Director of Energy Resource  
10 Development for the resource acquisitions team.

11 **Q. What are your duties as Director of Energy Resource Development for PSE?**

12 A. As the Director of Energy Resource Development, I am responsible for leading the  
13 development and implementation of strategies for expanding PSE’s energy supply  
14 portfolio to meet Clean Energy Transformation Act compliance requirements and to  
15 maintain reliability.

16 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

17 A. I graduated from the University of Massachusetts with a Bachelor of Science in  
18 Finance. My continued education includes training in energy trading and financial  
19 swaps and options from Paradigm Energy Training, as well as a certificate in  
20 Utility Management from Willamette University.

1 Prior to assuming my current role as Director of Energy Resource Development, I  
2 was Manager of Resource Acquisitions for PSE from October 2020 to August  
3 2023. In that role, I was responsible for the administration of PSE’s All Source  
4 Requests for Proposals (“RFP”) and management of the acquisition of electric  
5 resources for PSE and contracts for long-term electric supply.

6 From January 2020 to September 2020, I was a Commercial Acquisitions  
7 Manager for PSE. In that role, I supported and led negotiations and due diligence  
8 for the short list resource selections from the 2018 All Source RFP.

9 From June 2019 to January 2020, I was Origination and Structuring Manager for  
10 PSE. In that role, I administered a short-term RFP and coordinated energy  
11 modeling valuations to respond to resource opportunities, including Mid-C hydro  
12 auctions.

13 From 2015 to 2019, I was Manager of Power Supply Operations for PSE. In that  
14 role, I managed the trade floor as PSE joined the CAISO Energy Imbalance  
15 Market. I also led key merchant functions such as energy trading and energy  
16 analytics.

17 From 2013 to 2015, I was Manager of Portfolio Hedging. In that role, I managed  
18 the administration of PSE’s hedging programs for power and gas.

19 From 2005 to 2013, I held several individual contributor Energy Trader and  
20 Energy Scheduling positions at PSE. I was responsible for asset optimization of  
21 PSE resources, execution of financial and physical transactions, and delivery of  
22 energy supply to serve PSE customers.

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From 1999 to 2005, I participated as a co-founder in a technology startup and performed business and industry due diligence for Sunbelt Business Brokers.

From 1996 to 1999, I served as an Account Manager at Shell Energy. In this role, I coordinated the management of financial and physical energy requirements for industrial customers.
