**OVERVIEW**

- 1 This docket presents the Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission”) the opportunity to consider and, if appropriate, mandate measures to forestall the need to create new area codes within the 360 and 509 area codes. Area codes are also called “Numbering Plan Areas” or “NPAs”.
  
- 2 **This Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments applies only to the 509 NPA.** The Commission addressed the issue of mandatory thousand-block number pooling for the 360 NPA through an order issued January 24, 2007.

**BACKGROUND**

- 3 When a telecommunications company offers service to a new customer, it usually needs to offer that customer a telephone number. Historically, telecommunications companies received from the Pooling Administrator<sup>1</sup> a block of 10,000 telephone numbers at a time, which is the maximum number of telephone numbers available under a specific “prefix,” such as “644”-XXXX.

<sup>1</sup> The Pooling Administrator is the entity charged with overseeing the assignment of area codes, three-digit central office codes, and other “numbering resources” throughout the North American Numbering Plan Area (NANPA), which includes Washington. The Pooling Administrator also works with the telecommunications industry in developing area code relief plans. Neustar, Inc. is currently the Pooling Administrator for the NANPA. Neustar, Inc. was selected by the Federal Communications Commission for this role.

- 4 Within an area code or NPA (such as 360 or 509 in Washington) there are a finite number of prefixes. Therefore, while there is a very large number of telephone numbers available within an area code, that number is finite.
- 5 Eventually, the emergence of competition, the development of new technologies and population growth will cause the available telephone numbers within an area code to be used up, and one or more new area codes will need to be created. However, conservation measures are available to forestall the need for creating new area codes.
- 6 One such conservation measure is the implementation of “thousands-block number pooling.” Thousands-block number pooling means each block of 10,000 telephone numbers is broken down into 10 blocks of 1,000 numbers each. These 10 blocks of 1,000 numbers are “pooled,” which means each block of 1,000 telephone numbers is available to different telecommunications companies.<sup>2</sup> This measure more efficiently utilizes available telephone numbers, and significantly delays the need for new area codes.

## JURISDICTION

- 7 Historically, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has had exclusive jurisdiction for allocating telephone numbers for telecommunications companies in this state.<sup>3</sup> However, on December 6, 2005 the Commission petitioned the FCC to grant it authority to implement mandatory thousands-block number pooling within the 360 and 509 NPAs. The FCC granted the Commission’s petition on November 9, 2006.<sup>4</sup>

<sup>2</sup> For example, assume a particular telecommunications company needed only 500 new telephone numbers. Without thousands-block number pooling, that company would receive 10,000 numbers, thus “stranding” some 9,500 numbers until the company acquired thousands of new customers, which could take years. By contrast, under thousands-block number pooling, that company would receive a block of 1,000 numbers, and the remaining 9,000 numbers in the original 10,000 number block would be available immediately to customers of other companies.

<sup>3</sup> *E.g.*, 47 U.S.C. § 251(e) (FCC is granted authority to administer the portions of the “North American Numbering Plan” that apply to the United States).

<sup>4</sup> In re Numbering Resource Optimization, Petition for Delegated Authority by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, Petition of the New York State Department of Public Service for Mandatory Pooling, Petition of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for Mandatory Number Pooling, the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission’s Petition for Delegated Authority to Implement Additional Number Conservation Measures, CC Docket No. 99-200, DA 06-2299 (November 9, 2006).

8 According to the Pooling Administrator, there is mandatory thousands-block number pooling in 71 of 130 rate centers in the 509 NPA.<sup>5</sup> Number pooling currently is only optional in the other 59 rate centers in the 509 NPA.

### RATE CENTERS AND CARRIERS AT ISSUE

9 The Commission will consider whether mandatory number pooling should be required for the 56 rate centers in this state for which number pooling is currently only optional. The 509 rate centers at issue are listed in Appendix A. According to the Pooling Administrator, telecommunications companies (carriers) utilizing numbers in those rate centers and who may be interested in this proceeding are listed in Appendix B.

### PUBLIC COMMENT

10 The Commission issues this notice to interested persons, calling for written comments. At its March 28, 2007 open meeting, the Commission plans to consider the comments and address the issues raised in this docket.

11 **WRITTEN AND ORAL COMMENTS.** Interested persons may submit written comments to the Commission Secretary no later than **March 5, 2007**, for consideration at the Open Meeting scheduled for March 28, 2007. The Commission will also receive oral comments at its March 28, 2007, Open Meeting. Interested persons may submit comments electronically or delivery to the Commission's secretary at 1300 S. 12 We encourage commenter's to discuss any issues that they believe will assist the Commission to meet its goal of conserving numbering resources in the 509 area code. Topics for discussion may include:

- The impacts on small businesses and other businesses caused by area code changes.
- The impacts on consumers caused by area code changes.

<sup>5</sup> A "rate center" is a carrier-designated geographic location. Telephone numbers are assigned by rate center. For example, all of a carrier's customers who have telephone numbers with the same prefix (*e.g.*, "664"-XXXX) are in the same rate center.

- The benefits of number pooling.
- The impacts on telephone carriers from expanded mandatory pooling.
- Whether the Commission should mandate thousands-block number pooling in order to conserve numbering resources and extend the life of the 509 area code, and if so:
- Whether the Commission should impose any special requirements or permit any exemptions for specific telecommunications companies or under specific circumstances, such as customer needs.

The Commission offers this list to assist interested persons in preparing their comments. The list is not intended to limit the issues that may be addressed in those comments.
