On October 20, 2022, Avista Corporation, doing business as Avista Utilities (Avista or the Company), filed with the Commission a petition for an order approving its four-year demand and resource supply forecast pursuant to RCW 70A.65.120, the Climate Commitment Act. On January 24, 2023, the Commission issued Order 01 granting the Company's petition. On June 22, 2023, Avista filed a petition for an amended order approving its revised four-year demand and resource supply forecast. On July 27, 2023, the Commission issued Order 02 approving the Company's revised forecast. The Company hereby petitions the Commission for an order approving a revised 2026 demand and resource supply forecast. The Department of Ecology has stated they need an approved revised forecast by July 30th. As such, Avista requests an order on this matter before that date.
