**NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

RE: In the Matter of the Petition of Qwest Corporation to Initiate a Mass-Market Switching and Dedicated Transport Case Pursuant to the Triennial Review Order, Docket No. UT-033044.

TO ALL PARTIES:

By letter sent via e-mail today, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) requests a one-day extension of time to file the first round of testimony in this proceeding from Friday, December 19, 2003, to Monday, December 22, 2003.
