5 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

6 A. My name is Daniel A. Doyle, and my business address is 355 110th Avenue NE,
7 Bellevue, Washington 98004.

8 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

9 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) as Chief Financial Officer.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Chief Financial Officer for PSE?**

11 A. As Chief Financial Officer, I have the overall responsibility for the financial
12 management and financial health of PSE, which includes communicating with the
13 financial community, overseeing financial strategy and financing programs, and
14 overseeing PSE’s financial regulatory strategy before the Washington Utilities
15 and Transportation Commission and before the Federal Energy Regulatory
16 Commission.

17 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

18 A. I have more than 40 years of experience in the public utility industry. From
19 November, 2011 to September 2021 I was employed by Puget Sound Energy, first
20 as Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Puget Sound Energy, and
21 later as Senior Vice President, Office of the CEO. Following my initial departure

1 from PSE in September 2021, I founded and am the Principal of Antler Crest
2 Advisory, LLC where I provide strategic, financial and regulatory advisory
3 services to the regulated public utility industry. I returned to PSE on September
4 26th, 2023 and currently hold the role of Chief Financial Officer.

5 I am a certified public accountant, licensed in WI, and have personally testified on
6 a variety of matters in utility regulatory proceedings in Vermont, New Hampshire,
7 Iowa, and Wisconsin. I have also testified before the Federal Energy Regulatory
8 Commission. In addition to providing testimony, I have served clients in
9 regulatory proceedings before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and
10 the Kentucky, Indiana, and Illinois utility commissions with respect to electric
11 and gas clients and a dozen other states with respect to water and sewer clients.

12 Prior to joining PSE, I worked in several diverse roles within the regulated public
13 utility industry. From October 2000 to July 2009, I served as Vice President,
14 Chief Financial Officer, and Treasurer of American Transmission Company LLC
15 (“ATC”). As a Member of the leadership team and Officer at ATC’s first multi-
16 state, transmission-only utility, I was responsible for overseeing the financial,
17 information technology and human resource functions. Prior to ATC, I was
18 employed by Alliant Energy Corporation (“Alliant Energy”) and its various
19 predecessor companies. I held various positions at Alliant Energy, including
20 Controller and Treasurer, Vice President of Finance, Vice President of Power
21 Production and Wholesale Services, and Vice President of Manufacturing and
22 Energy Portfolio Services. During my tenure at Alliant Energy, I was responsible

1 for accounting and financing matters and strategic financial planning matters,
2 including merger analysis, dividend policies and asset rationalization initiatives. I
3 also managed approximately 5,000 megawatts of generating facilities as well as
4 the energy trading functions. In January 2000 I became Alliant Energy's Vice
5 President and Chief Accounting and Financial Planning Officer. Prior to joining
6 Alliant Energy, I served as a Senior Audit Manager of Arthur Andersen & Co. for
7 eight years and as Controller of Central Vermont Service Corp. for four years.

8 I have a Bachelor of Arts degree in Accounting from Michigan State University. I
9 also have a Masters of Business Administration in General Management and
10 Technology from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York.
