On May 15, 2000, Georgia-Pacific West, Inc. (Complainant) filed with the Commission a Complaint against Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (Respondent). Respondent filed its Answer on June 5, 2000. The pleadings indicate that a dispute exists between the Complainant and Respondent related to allegations that Respondent has violated its special contract with Complainant with respect to an equipment lease and changeover procedures. A more detailed account of the dispute is reflected in the foregoing pleadings which are available for inspection at the Commission's offices, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. It is appropriate for the matters raised in the pleadings to be brought to a hearing before the Commission.

Hearing in this matter is being held pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 pertaining to Adjudicative Proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440 , RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under Title 80 RCW, having legal authority to regulate the rates, services, and practices of electric utilities. The statutes and rules involved include those within chapters 80.04 and 80.28 RCW and chapters 480-09 and 480-100 WAC. The issues involved are generally stated above and more specifically contained in the pleadings herein.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in accordance with WAC 480-09-700(1)(a), the Commission has determined that good cause exists for this matter to be heard upon a shortened notice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That a prehearing conference will be held at 9:30 a.m., on Wednesday, July 19, 2000, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. Parties who plan to participate in the prehearing conference must appear in person or through a duly authorized representative appearing in person on their behalf. Those present at the prehearing conference will be required to consider formulating any other issues in the proceeding and to determine other matters to aid in its disposition, as specified in WAC 480-09-460. Petitions to intervene should be made in writing prior to that date or made orally at that time. Appearances will be taken. The time and place for any additional hearings will be set at the prehearing conference or by later written notice.

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT ANY PARTY WHO FAILS TO ATTEND OR PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING SET HEREIN, OR OTHER STAGE OF THIS PROCEEDING, MAY BE HELD IN DEFAULT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF RCW 34.05.440. THE PARTIES ARE FURTHER ADVISED THAT THE SANCTION PROVISIONS OF WAC 480-09-700(4) ARE SPECIFICALLY INVOKED.
