- This is a notice of a brief adjudicative proceeding to address the failure of registered telecommunications companies listed in Appendix A to pay their regulatory fee and/or file their annual report on or before May 1, 2000, or at any time since that date.
- The entities listed in Appendix A of this notice have been registered as telecommunications companies pursuant to chapter 80.36 RCW and were thereby authorized to provide specific telecommunications services for compensation within the state of Washington.
- RCW 80.04.080 requires public service companies to furnish annual reports to the Commission in such form as the Commission may require. WAC 480-120-031 and WAC 480-120-033 of the Commission's rules and regulations governing telecommunications companies provide that annual reports must be filed with the Commission not later than May 1 of the year following the year covered by the annual report. RCW 80.24.010 provides that, on or before the date specified by the Commission for filing annual reports, each company is to pay to the Commission the appropriate regulatory fee.
- Issues addressed will include whether the companies' registrations should be revoked pursuant to WAC 480-121-060, which in part allows the Commission to revoke registrations for failure to file an annual report or pay regulatory fees.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-09-500(1), the Commission determines that this matter is appropriate for a brief adjudicative proceeding to be conducted in accordance with the provisions of RCW 34.05.485, RCW 34.05.488, RCW 34.05.491, RCW 34.05.494, and WAC 480-09-500.
