On December 4, 2001, a joint application, D-79032, was filed for authority to transfer all rights under said Certificate No. 1052 to SEATTLE EXPRESS, INC.

It appears that SEATTLE EXPRESS, INC. is able and willing to furnish all services necessary under Certificate No. 1052, and that the transfer to him of all rights as requested will not be detrimental to the interests of the public.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That the application be, and the same is, hereby granted, conditioned upon compliance by all parties concerned with the law and rules governing auto transportation companies, and subject to any legal claims, liens or equities.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1052 be reissued to SEATTLE EXPRESS, INC.

All parties interested should take notice that the Commission in granting authority for the transfer of rights

under a certificate does not necessarily approve the amount involved in the transaction, nor does it bind itself to recognize such amount in placing a value for rate-making purposes on the property of the certificate holder.
