- 1 On October 30, 2002, Central Washington Airporter filed an application (number D-079116) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate Motor Vehicles in Furnishing Passenger and Express Service as an Auto Transportation Company (Application). Notice of the Application was published in the Commission's weekly Docket of November 25, 2002.
- 2 The Application requests authority to provide passenger service between Yakima, Ellensburg, Cle Elum and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and selected points in downtown Seattle, with service to intermediate points via State Route 97 and Interstate Highways 5, 82, 90 and 405, with no service between any points within King County. The Commission received no protests within the 20 days required by WAC 480-30-032(1). RCW 81.68.040 requires that the Commission grant authority in a territory already served only after hearing.
- ³ The hearing set by this notice will be held pursuant to Chapter 34.05 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under Title 81 RCW, having legal authority to regulate persons seeking to furnish auto transportation services under chapter 81.68 RCW. Statutes involved include RCW 81.68.030, RCW 81.68.040, and RCW 81.68.070. Rules involved include those within chapter 480-30 WAC, particularly WAC 480-30-020 and WAC 480-30-030. Also involved are rules within chapter 480-09 WAC relating to practice and procedure.

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- 4 The ultimate issues involved are whether granting the Application would be consistent with the foregoing statutes and otherwise consistent with the public interest. The Applicant has the burden of showing that it has met the requirements of the applicable statutes and Commission rules.
- 5 The Commission designates Lawrence J. Berg as the presiding officer.
