The applications appeared on the May 5, 2003, application docket. No one filed a protest, intervention, or application for overlapping authority during the docket and protest period.

Under the provisions of RCW 81.77.040 any certificate may be sold, assigned, leased, transferred, or inherited as property, but only on authorization by the Commission.

The transferors and the transferee have no outstanding penalties, fines, administrative, or compliance actions pending before the commission. Staff has received no other information indicating that any of these applications should be set for hearing.

Therefore, I recommend the requested transfers be granted without hearing and the file be referred to staff for processing.
