Subject: AT&T Safety Valve Request for Bellevue Rate Center

Ms. Washburn,

AT&T respectfully submits this request for Application of the "safety valve" for NXX-X Acquisition in the state of Washington. By this letter, AT&T requests that the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") overturn a denial by NeuStar, Inc. ("NeuStar", "Pooling Administrator" or "PA") of AT&T's application for blocks of telephone numbers and that the Commission authorize the PA to release the requested numbers to AT&T so that AT&T may serve its customer.

This request is based on the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Rules found at 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(4) and pursuant to the Thousands-Block Number (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guidelines and the Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines published by the Industry Numbering Committee ("INC").¹

A Washington customer of AT&T has requested that AT&T provide numbers from three thousands-blocks for its place of business in the Bellevue rate center.² AT&T has developed a communications plan that the customer will implement, and consequently, the customer will assign the numbers soon after AT&T makes them available. The customer's dial plan requires the NXX be from the 425 NPA and more specifically must end with 6 (e.g., NX6), and provide numbers in the 5, 6 and 8 blocks to meet specific needs.

On July 16, 2004, AT&T submitted a "Thousand Block Application Form Part 1A", and a "Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet – TN Level" ("MTE and Utilization") to the PA for three blocks³ in the Bellevue rate center.

During the online session with the Pooling Administration System ("PAS"), AT&T received an error message indicating the request would not process through the system due to a utilization rate lower than the required percentage.⁴ The PA applies the FCC rules and INC Guidelines. These rules and guidelines require that a block holder requesting growth resources demonstrate that existing resources within the rate center will both exhaust within 6.0 months, and meet the 75% utilization level. The error message indicated the utilization level was not met.

Due to the nature of the customer's request, a new NXX will need to be opened meet their need. Despite an abundance of blocks available in the Bellevue

number pool, there are no combination of blocks that meet the NXX and blocks requested. The 425 NPA, as noted on the North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA") web site⁵, has approximately 302 available NXXs and an exhaust date more than twenty years in the future. Consequently, the opening of a new NXX does not appear to result in more than a small incremental change in the life of the 425 NPA. If requested by the Commission, AT&T would attempt to donate uncontaminated or contaminated blocks in it's Bellevue rate center inventory up to a total of three to offset these proposed acquisitions.

AT&T respectfully requests that the Commission overturn the PA's decision expeditiously in the interest of our customer, as we are unable to satisfy the numbering needs of this customer without such an exception. Contact with the PA for the state of Washington may be made as follows:


