As you are aware, on July 18, 2005, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("commission") issued a Penalty Assessment against you in the amount of \$4,000 for violations of a January 6, 2005, Order in Docket TE-040835, in which the commission canceled your operating authority.

The commission has not received the \$4,000 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$4,000 balance.
