I have read and understand RCW 9A.72.020, which states that making false statements under oath is a class B felony (printed below). I am over the age of 18, am competent to testify to the matters set forth below and I have personal knowledge of those matters. I hereby make, under oath, application for mitigation of the penalties (as described in the attached Notice of Penalties), for the following reasons:

- 1) Advantage Telecommunications Corp received a letter dated June 3, 2005 stating that their Annual Report had been received on time (copy of letter is attached).
- 2) Check number 1280 was included with the original report and Advantage still received a letter stating that no payment was ever received by the state. A copy of the original check is included, along with the bank confirmation stopping payment.
- 3) Advantage issued the state another check in the amount of \$143.07 as requested. There should be no penalty imposed upon Advantage for correcting a mistake that was made by the state of Washington.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct.

(1) A person is guilty of perjury in the first degree in any official proceeding he makes a materially false statement which he knows to be false under an oath required or authorized by law. (2) Knowledge of the materiality of the statement is not an element of this crime, and the actor’s mistaken belief that his statement was not material is not a defense to a prosecution under this section. (3) Perjury in the first degree is a class B felony.”
