YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR A DISCOUNT ON LOCAL PHONE SERVICE

There are two telephone assistance programs available in Washington to help low income consumers receive and maintain local phone service. The Washington Telephone Assistance Program (WTAP) consists of Lifeline Assistance and Lifeline Connection Assistance (Link-Up).

These government programs were developed to reduce phone rates for qualified low income residential customers. Lifeline Assistance credits will reduce your monthly local service charges. Link-Up credits will reduce connection charges on the installation of a single access line for the primary residence.

Residential customers receiving continuing financial or medical assistance from the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) and providing proof of eligibility qualify for WTAP. Eligible programs include but are not limited to:

- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
- Food Stamps
- General Assistance
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Medical Assistance
- Refugee Assistance
- DSHS Chore Services
- Community Options Program (COPES)

AFFIDAVIT CERTIFYING USE OF UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUNDS

- I, Kevin G. Hess, being of lawful age and duly sworn, on my oath state that I am Vice-President, Federal Affairs [an officerl of TDS Telecommunications Corporation, parent company of Asotin Telephone Company ("Company"), that I am authorized to execute this affidavit on behalf of the Company, and that the facts set forth in this affidavit are true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief. certify to the Washington Utilities Transportation Commission ("Commission"), for use by the Commission in providing the certification to the Federal Commission and Universal Communications Service Administrative Company required by 47 C.F.R. § 54.314, as follows:
 - (1) that during the calendar year 2004, the Company provided the supported services required by 47 U.S.C. § 214(e) and as described in the Commission Order granting the Company Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") status;
 - (2) that during the 2004 calendar year, the Company advertised the availability of supported services and the charges for them as required by 47 U.S.C. § 214(e) and as described in the Commission Order granting the Company ETC status;
 - (3) that the Company is eligible to receive federal high-cost universal service support from the sources described in 47 C.F.R. § 54.314;
 - (4) that funds from the sources described in 47 C.F.R. §54.314 received by the Company will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of the facilities and services for which the support is intended;
 - (5) that the amount of federal high-cost universal service fund support received by the Company for calendar year 2004 was \$297,371; and

(6) the loop counts on which federal highcost universal service support received by the Company for the calendar year 2004 was based were as follows: for the first quarter of calendar year 2004, 1427; for the second quarter of calendar year 2004, 1427; for the third quarter of calendar year 2004, 1427; and for the fourth quarter of calendar year 2004, 1427.
