3. The temporary 1.14% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of November 2006 and December 2006, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of February 2007 & March 2007.

Customers who are billed bi-monthly for services -current month and one month ahead:  
The surcharge will appear on the February 2007 billing and applies to all services provided in the months of February 2007 and March 2007 and in the March 2007 billing to all services provided in the months of March 2007 and April 2007.
