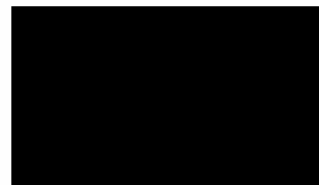

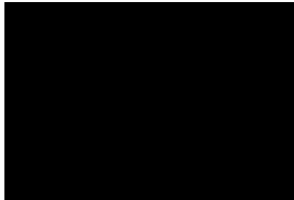
Dear Jeff,

[Redacted] located at [Redacted] is expanding the existing campus through construction of additional facilities this year and upcoming years. As a result of this 5 year growth plan and long range planning, [Redacted] will require additional phone numbers for the campus. Several times in the past, [Redacted] has requested limited blocks of numbers, only to run out and need additional numbers. These requests have required multiple prefixes which have caused problems for [Redacted]. [Redacted] would now like to reserve an entire NXX block to accommodate this future growth.

As part of the campus expansion beginning this Spring/Summer 2008: (505 new numbers)
We are opening a new housing facility, which will require 250 new numbers.
The [Redacted] and associated programs are expanding and will move into a newly remodeled [Redacted] which will require 100 new numbers.
Phase I of the [Redacted] will be complete and require 50 new numbers
[Redacted] is expanding their program and their new addition will be complete and required 50 new numbers.
Parking Garage structure will be complete and require 30 new numbers
[Redacted] will be renovated for academic use and require 50 new numbers

2009 (350 new numbers)
Phase II and III of the Soccer Complex will be complete and require 50 new numbers
Phase I of the [Redacted] to accommodate student residence will be complete and require 300 new numbers





2010 (150 to 300 new numbers)
Phase II and possibly III of the [redacted] to accommodate student residence will be complete and require 300 new numbers

2012/Long Range Planning over the next 10 years... (430 new numbers)
Construction of a new [redacted] for program expansion will require 250 new numbers.
Construction of a new [redacted] complex for program expansion will require 150 new numbers.
Construction of a new parking garage to accommodate campus growth will require 30 new numbers.

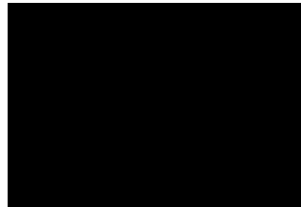
[redacted] will replace most of the active series of numbers which currently operate with the prefixes [redacted] with the new prefix provided by Qwest. Exceptions see chart attached in red.

[redacted] spring semester ends in May so we would like to activate the new numbers on June 1, 2008 which will coordinate with the academic schedule.

If possible [redacted] would like to keep the staff/faculty numbers currently beginning with [redacted] along with the new prefix for a few months after the June 1, 2008 date to ease transition from the old number to the new number. However, the Student extensions in range of [redacted] can be deactivated as soon as the new prefix and those ranges are activated as of June 1st. (Exception [redacted] will need to stay active along with the new prefix [redacted] since this is the on-campus emergency/security number).

[redacted] is the campus main number to our Switchboard and Auto Attendant and is in all of [redacted] publications. [redacted] also need to remain active.

[redacted] will return 5000 +/- numbers during the course of conversion to the new NXX. For ease of transition, we require the returned numbers receive intercept recordings for 1 year, or the life of the directory.

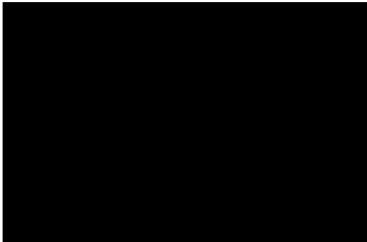
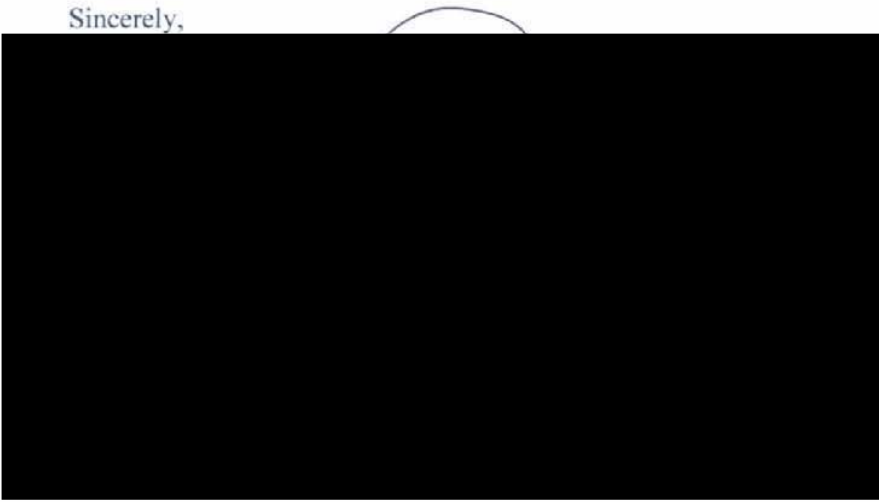

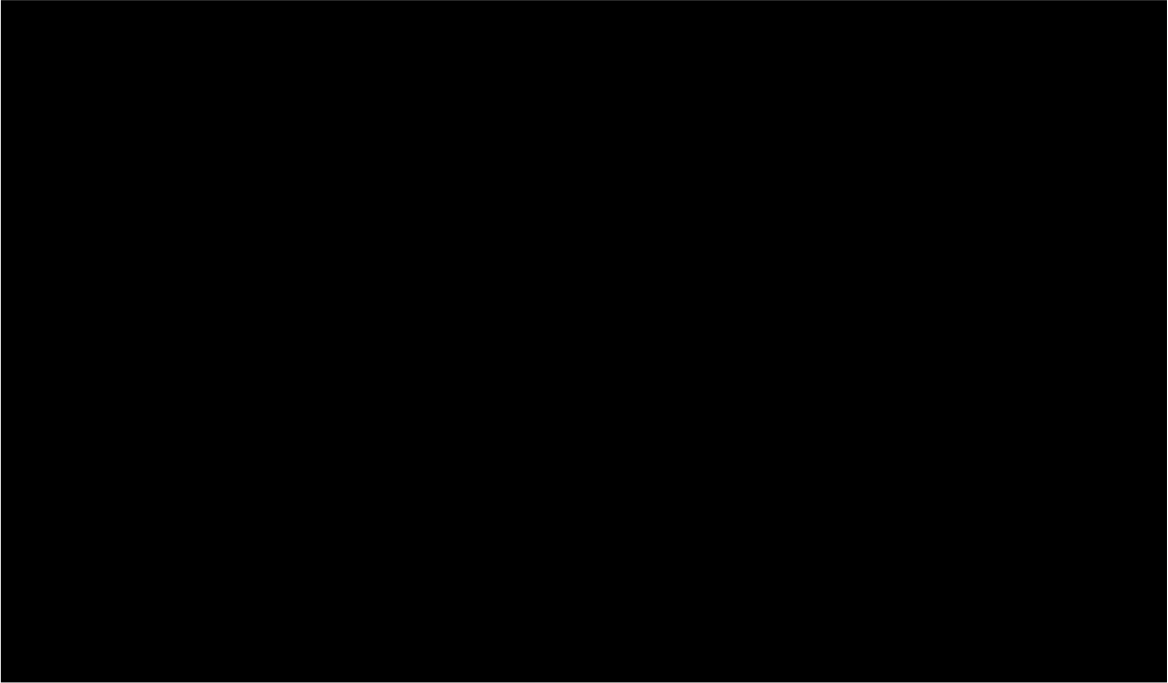
