**BACKGROUND**

- 1     On April 24, 2008, Operator Service Company, LLC (OSC or Company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition for an extension of time to file its annual report for 2007 as required by [WAC 480-120-382](#). According to OSC, it is unable to prepare the report due to inconsistent formatting of data received. OSC seeks an extension until June 1, 2008.
- 2     Commission Staff reviewed the request and recommended granting OSC’s request for temporary exemption.

**FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

- 3     (1)    The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate public service companies, including competitively classified telecommunications companies. [RCW 80.01.040](#), [RCW 80.04](#) and [RCW 80.36](#).
- 4     (2)    OSC is a competitively classified telecommunications company and a public service company subject to Commission jurisdiction.
- 5     (3)    OSC is subject to [WAC 480-120-382](#), which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report no later than May 1 of each year.

- 6 (4) Under WAC [480-120-015](#), the Commission may grant an exemption from any rule in WAC [480-120](#), if consistent with the public interest, the purposes underlying regulation and applicable statutes. *See also* [WAC 480-07-110](#).
- 7 (5) Granting the requested temporary exemption will enable the company to provide a more complete and informative report.
- 8 (6) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on April 30, 2008.
- 9 (7) After reviewing the petition OSC filed in Docket UT-080694 on April 24, 2008, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is reasonable and should be granted.

**O R D E R**

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

- 10 (1) Operator Service Company, LLC's petition for an exemption from WAC 480-120-382 for an extension until June 1, 2008, to file its 2007 annual report is granted.
- 11 (2) Failure by Operator Service Company, LLC to file its annual report by June 1, 2008, may result in the Commission invoking [RCW 80.04.405](#), which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rules and Commission orders.
- 12 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Operator Service Company, LLC to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Executive Secretary to enter this Order.
