#### **BACKGROUND**

- On April 24, 2008, WDT World Discount Telecommunications Co. (WDT or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition for an extension of time to file its annual report for 2007 as required by WAC 480-120-382. According to WDT, it is unable to prepare the report due to inconsistent formatting of data received. WDT seeks an extension until June 1, 2008.
- 2 Commission Staff reviewed the request and recommended granting WDT's request for temporary exemption.

### FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate public service companies, including competitively classified telecommunications companies. *RCW* 80.01.040, *RCW* 80.04 and *RCW* 80.36.
- 4 (2) WDT is a competitively classified telecommunications company and a public service company subject to Commission jurisdiction.
- 5 (3) WDT is subject to WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report no later than May 1 of each year.

- 6 (4) Under WAC 480-120-015, the Commission may grant an exemption from any rule in WAC 480-120, if consistent with the public interest, the purposes underlying regulation and applicable statutes. *See also WAC 480-07-110*.
- 7 (5) Granting the requested temporary exemption will enable the company to provide a more complete and informative report.
- 8 (6) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on April 30, 2008.
- 9 (7) After reviewing the petition WDT filed in Docket UT-080696 on April 24, 2008, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is reasonable and should be granted.

#### ORDER

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- WDT World Discount Telecommunications Co.'s petition for an exemption from WAC 480-120-382 for an extension until June 1, 2008, to file its 2007 annual report is granted.
- 11 (2) Failure by WDT World Discount Telecommunications Co. to file its annual report by June 1, 2008, may result in the Commission invoking RCW 80.04.405, which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rules and Commission orders.
- 12 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and WDT World Discount Telecommunications Co. to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Executive Secretary to enter this Order.
