BACKGROUND

- 1 On April 30, 2008, Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc. (Integra or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition for an extension of time to file its annual report for 2007 as required by [WAC 480-120-382](#). According to Integra, it is unable to prepare the report due to unexpected staff departures and delays in assembling necessary information. Integra seeks an extension until June 1, 2008.
- 2 Commission Staff reviewed the request and recommended granting Integra’s request for exemption.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 3 (1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate public service companies, including competitively classified telecommunications companies. [RCW 80.01.040](#), [RCW 80.04](#) and [RCW 80.36](#).
- 4 (2) Integra is a competitively classified telecommunications company and a public service company subject to Commission jurisdiction.

- 5 (3) Integra is subject to [WAC 480-120-382](#), which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report no later than May 1 of each year.
- 6 (4) Under [WAC 480-120-015](#), the Commission may grant an exemption from any rule in [WAC 480-120](#), if consistent with the public interest, the purposes underlying regulation and applicable statutes. *See also* [WAC 480-07-110](#).
- 7 (5) Exemption is appropriate in this case in order to ensure that the company's annual report is complete, based upon the best information available and prepared by a qualified professional.
- 8 (6) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 15, 2008.
- 9 (7) After reviewing the petition Integra filed in Docket UT-080747 on April 30, 2008, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is reasonable and should be granted.

O R D E R

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 10 (1) Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc.'s petition for an exemption from [WAC 480-120-382](#) for an extension until June 1, 2008, to file its 2007 annual report is granted.
- 11 (2) Failure of Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc., to file its annual report by June 1, 2008, may result in the Commission invoking [RCW 80.04.405](#), which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rules and Commission orders.
- 12 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc. to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Executive Secretary to enter this Order.
