

- 5 (3) Seattle Portland Express is subject to WAC 480-30-071(1), which requires auto transportation companies to file an annual report by May 1 of each year.
- 6 (4) Under WAC 480-30-071(1)(c), the Commission may grant an extension of time allowing the Company to file its annual report after the May 1 due date if the Commission receives a request for extension before May 1.
- 7 (5) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 15, 2008
- 8 (6) After reviewing Seattle Portland Express' petition filed in Docket TC-080772 on April 30, 2008, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is reasonable and should be granted.

O R D E R

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The Commission grants the request of Seattle Portland Express Co. for an extension of time to file its 2007 annual report until May 30, 2008.
- 10 (2) Failure by Seattle Portland Express Co. to file its 2007 annual report by May 30, 2008, may result in the Commission invoking RCW 81.04.405, which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rule, and Commission orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Seattle Portland Express Co. to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Executive Secretary to enter this Order.
