Dear Mr. Harlow:

On February 21, 2008, Kalama Telephone Company (Kalama) filed a joint request for approval of a Traffic Exchange Agreement (agreement) between Kalama and United States Cellular Corporation (US Cellular) in Docket UT-083008. The agreement is a delegated item scheduled for approval by May 16, 2008.

The agreement is 49 days late. The commission reserves the right to investigate, and if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain, enforce, and penalize US Cellular for failure to meet the filing requirements of Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. WAC 480-07-640 (effective January 1, 2004) requires interconnection agreements be filed for approval within 30 days after the agreement is signed. A similar letter has been sent to Kalama.
