Re: Extension of the Section 252 Negotiation Timeframe between Qwest Corporation and Charter Fiberlink for the States of Minnesota and Washington

Dear Mr. Bastiampillai:

This letter follows our recent discussions concerning the ongoing interconnection agreement negotiations between Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), and the Charter Fiberlink companies ("Charter") in the states of Minnesota and Washington. Pursuant to the terms set forth herein, Charter and Qwest agree to stipulate to March 1, 2008 as the date that Qwest received Charter's request for negotiations of an interconnection agreement.

Based on a request for negotiations date of March 1, 2008, the 135th day (the opening of the arbitration window) will fall on July 14, 2008 and the 160th day (the closing of the arbitration window) will fall on August 8, 2008.

We both understand that our agreement upon these dates in this case is based on the particular circumstances here. It is entirely without prejudice to either party's respective position with regard to when any other Section 252(a) request might be deemed to have been received either in general or in any other particular case.

Please confirm that this agreement for the negotiation period is acceptable to Qwest by counter signing this letter and returning an original signature to me.

Thank you for your attention to this matter.




Re: Request for Renegotiation of Interconnection Agreement Between Qwest and Charter Fiberlink for the State of Washington
