This contract replaces an expiring contract for PS-ALI service, which enables 911 calls from the customers' phone system to be properly routed. The current contract expires at the end of the day on June 3, 2009. The customer returned the signed agreement to the Company later than requested, which has resulted the contract not being filed in time for the 30 day notice period to allow it to become effective on June 4. The Company is requesting the contract become effective on less than required notice in order to avoid a gap in this important service. (Note that this agreement is the same -- except for the customer -- as the one filed on May as 1392ICB, requesting a June 4 effective date.)


