Item 20 -- Definitions, continued

Solid waste  
receptacle, cont'd:

**Can** means a receptacle made of durable, corrosion-resistant, nonabsorbent material that is watertight, and has a close-fitting cover and two handles. A can holds more than twenty gallons, but not more than thirty-two gallons. A can may not weigh more than 65 pounds when filled nor more than 12 pounds when empty.

**Cart** means a wheeled plastic container. A cart may also be referred to as a toter. If supplied by a customer, a cart must be compatible with the company's equipment. The size and type of cart that is compatible will be established in each company's tariff.

**Container** means a detachable receptacle (normally designed to hold at least a cubic yard of solid waste) from which materials are collected by mechanically lifting the receptacle and emptying the contents into the company's vehicle.

**Drop box** means a detachable receptacle used to provide solid waste collection service by the receptacle being placed on the company's vehicle by mechanical means and transported to a disposal site.

**Drum** means a metal or plastic container of approximately fifty five gallon capacity, generally used for oils or solvents. A drum may not weigh more than 75 pounds when filled.

**Litter receptacle** means a container not over 45 gallon capacity, generally placed in shopping centers and along streets or highways for litter. A litter receptacle may not weigh more than 65 pounds when filled.

**Micro-mini can** means a can made of durable, corrosion-resistant, nonabsorbent material that is watertight and has a close-fitting cover. A micro-mini can may not hold more than ten gallons. A micro-mini can may not weigh more than N/A pounds when filled.

**Mini-can** means a can made of durable, corrosion-resistant, nonabsorbent material that is watertight and has a close-fitting cover. A mini-can may not hold more than twenty gallons. A mini-can may not weigh more than 35 pounds when filled.

**Recycling bin, cart (C) or container** means a bin or container designed or designated for the collection of recyclables. The size and type of recycling bin or container will be established in each company's tariff.

Item 52 -- Redelivery Fees

Residential curbside recycling will be picked up bi-weekly on a year round basis. Service rendered on the same day as solid waste collection.

Customers will receive a wheeled 96 gallon cart. Customers may request a 65 gallon cart if convenient. Materials to be collected are as follows:

- Newspaper: Includes only newspaper and catalogs made out of newsprint.
- Mixed Paper: All other paper products, including magazines and catalogs. Corrugated containers (Must be free of all food contaminates).
- Paper Cartons: Cartons as type used for milk and juice. Juice boxes are not accepted. (N)
- Aluminum: Aluminum cans and containers only. Cans must be flattened and placed in bin.
- Metal Containers: Food quality tin cans only.
- Plastics: All grades of plastic will be accepted if the neck of the container is smaller than the base of the container. Plastic containers that are contaminated with motor oil or other hazardous materials, such as pesticides, will not be accepted. (C)
- Glass: ~~Food grade glass only. No broken, ceramic or tempered glass will be accepted.~~

If recyclable material is found to contain contaminates by inclusion of material not allowed or by contamination of materials the container will not be accepted as recyclable material and will be tagged for the customer to sort the material. If the contaminates or contaminated materials are not removed by the next schedules pick-up day they will be transported to the landfill at applicable solid waste collection rates as stated in carriers' tariff. Over 25 feet, the charge will be the charge for 25 feet, plus \$N/A per increment of 5 feet.
