**BACKGROUND**

1 On June 24, 2009, Net One International, Inc., filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for registration and petition for classification as a competitive telecommunications company in Docket UT-091009. The application and petition do not comply with the rules set forth in WACs 480-120 and 480-121.

**FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

2 Net One International, Inc.'s, registration form did not provide a Current Balance Sheet and it was not marked for a Competitive Classification. It's application and petition are therefore not in compliance with the rules set forth in WACs 480-120 and 480-121 and should be rejected.

**ORDER**

3 **THE COMMISSION REJECTS** the application and petition of Net One International, Inc., in its entirety. This Order does not preclude Net One International, Inc., from filing a later application and petition for registration as a competitive telecommunications company.

4 The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
