Dear Mr. Danner:

Please find attached copies of revisions for G-12 Tariff Number 4 for Rabanco Ltd. (dba Allied Waste of Lynnwood, Lynnwood Disposal, Maltby Division). This proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for single family residential customers in the Serivce Areas defined in Appendices A and B from a credit of \$0.06 to a credit of \$0.62 per month and for multi family customers, from a credit of \$0.07 to a credit of \$0.14 per yard. Enclosed are the accounting work papers.

The attached revenue sharing agreement certified by the county indicates a 50% retention rate for the company based on the new threshold approved via HB-2539.
