Sunshine Disposal has filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to increase rates in Lincoln, Adams and Whitman Counties effective October 1, 2010. This increase is to cover increased operating costs including disposal, taxes, fuel, labor, insurance and equipment. Our last rate increase took effect 1-1-2002.
