RE: 2010 Natural Gas Standard Inspection – Knotty Pine Apartments

On September 21, 2010, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (commission) pipeline safety staff met with you to discuss the natural gas master meter (MM) system located at the Knotty Pine Apartments in Spokane, Washington. During this meeting, you indicated that you no longer wanted to operate a MM system and that you are currently working with Avista Utilities to make the necessary system upgrades.

We understand that you have committed to submit a written plan to the commission describing the timelines and performed actions that will be taken to eliminate the existing MM system. We request receipt of this written information no later than October 22, 2010.

Docket PG-101403 will be closed once we have confirmed completion of the proposed work. Please refer to this docket number in any future correspondence pertaining to this inspection.
