On October 1, 2010 Puget Sound Energy (the “Company”) filed with the Commission proposed changes to the Residential And Farm Energy Exchange Benefit affecting approximately 982,621 electric customers. Pursuant to WAC 480-100-198, Notice Verification and Assistance, the Company is providing this statement that it has posted the above-referenced filing in accordance with WAC 480-100-193, Posting of Tariffs for Public Inspection and Review, by the method outlined in Subsection (1) Web, Telephone, and Mail Access. The proposed tariff changes were posted to our Internet web site www.PSE.com on October 1, 2010.

The Company also states that a notice was published on October 1, 2010, as a paid advertisement in nine daily newspapers in the geographical areas affected. A copy of the paid advertisement is enclosed. A press release summarizing the published notice has been issued to the news editors of newspapers, television stations and radio stations within the Company’s service area. The notice was also forwarded to community action agencies and posted to our web site.
