Island County

Snohomish County - in accordance with the area described as the "Yard Debris Service Zone" per Chapter 7.42 of the Snohomish County Code.

Skagit County – the area described as the Skagit Golf and County Club reflected in the attached map designated as Exhibit B to this tariff.

Yard waste service is a sign-up program that is provided on an every other week basis year round. Customers who sign up for this program will be provided with one 96 gallon cart.
