RE: Request for Approval – Special Contract for Electric Service

Attached for filing with the Commission is an electronic copy of the Amended and Restated Electric Distribution Service Agreement between Avista (Company) and Consolidated Irrigation District No. 19 (Consolidated Irrigation or Consolidated). This Amended and Restated agreement replaces the original agreement filed with the Commission on July 26, 2011. The reason for the new Agreement is to reflect two changes that the Company and Consolidated agreed to, as contemplated by UTC Staff in their preliminary review. Those changes are:

Section 2 – added “which occurs on September 30, 2016” after “(3) expiration of the Transmission Agreement”.

Section 7.1 – Added language regarding the adjustment of the monthly service fee based on changes to Avista’s base retail rates.
