Section 6: Repair or Adjustment of Meters

Only employees or authorized representatives of the company are permitted to do any work on company meters or their connections.

Section 7: Meter Test at Customer Request (N) The company, at its expense, shall initiate a test of the accuracy of a meter within ten (10) working days after receipt of the request from a customer, provided the customer does not make a request for a test more frequently than once in any twelve-month period. If, at the customer's request, the meter is tested more frequently than once in twelve months and the results of the test show the meter to be either slow or registering within the allowable limits as reported by the company, then the customer shall pay a charge for the customer-requested second test and each of the subsequent tests within the twelve-month period in according to the charges below: a. Class 250 or Class 400 \$142 b. LP Delivery Class 1000 \$168 c. Meter not listed above \$408 If the meter is found to be fast or beyond the allowable limits, the Company shall assume the

Section 8: Metering Inaccuracies (T)

In the event of inaccurate matching on the company's records of meter number and customer service location, meter stoppage, or failure of meter to register or to register accurately, the customer will be billed for the billing period on an estimated consumption based upon:

- a. Check meter readings, if available and accurate;
- Correction of error if the percentage of error is ascertainable by calibration, tests, or mathematical calculation; or
- The use of gas in a similar period of like use under similar conditions when the meter was registering accurately.

Section 9: Inaccessible Meters (T)

If, for any reason whatsoever, the company's employees or authorized representatives cannot gain access to the meter for the purpose of reading its index, an estimated bill will be rendered and will be considered due and payable.
