Dear Ms. Douglass:

On May 21, 2012, Frontier Communications Northwest Inc. (Frontier) and Lightspeed Networks Inc., d/b/a LS Networks filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a request for approval of an interconnection agreement. The agreement is a delegated item scheduled for approval by August 19, 2012.

On June 19, 2012, Frontier filed with the Commission requests for approval of several interconnection agreement amendments that Frontier has with multiple CLECs (items 2 through 6). The amendments are also delegated items and scheduled for approval by September 16, 2012.

WAC 480-07-640 requires interconnection agreements or amendments be submitted for approval within 30 days after they are signed. The last signature appearing on the interconnection agreement or amendments range from March 30, 2012 to May 15, 2012; thus resulting in the interconnection agreement and/or amendments being filed anywhere from 5 days late to 39 days late. The Commission reserves the right to investigate and, if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain, enforce, and penalize Frontier for failure to meet the filing requirements.
