Dear Ms. Peterson:

On November 15, 2012, United Telephone Company of the Northwest d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink) and Spectrotel, Inc., filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a request for approval of an interconnection agreement (agreement). The agreement is a delegated item scheduled for approval by February 13, 2013.

WAC 480-07-640 requires interconnection agreements be submitted for approval within 30 days after they are signed. The last signature appearing on the agreement is dated August 29, 2012, the Commission should have received the agreement no later than September 28, 2012; therefore, the agreement was filed 48 days late. The Commission reserves the right to investigate and, if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain, enforce, and penalize CenturyLink for failure to meet the filing requirements.
