The Washington Movers Conference (WMC) would like to provide the following comments to the Commission's "Rulemaking to Review Insurance and Cancellation Rules for Household Goods Carriers in WAC 480-15 and Review Corrections and Clarifications to the Household Goods Rules in WAC 480-15", Docket TV-130079, dated February 19, 2013.

The following comments are provided:

Proposal to streamline the process for cancelling HHG Permits when the Commission receives notice that a HHG carrier's required liability insurance is scheduled to lapse.

- a. The WMC concurs in the Commission's proposal to streamline the process for cancelling HHG Permits. The new process would be to notify the HHG carrier 30 days in advance of the date insurance is due to lapse. The notice would advise the HHG carrier that its HHG Permit will be cancelled if the commission does not receive proof of insurance within 30 days.
- b. Change the WUTC web site procedure to allow removing the HHG carriers name from the list of "Open Cases" on the Household Goods Carriers page once the Proof of Insurance has been received by the Commission.
