## Dear Mr. King:

Attached you will find the above-referenced tariff sheets. One purpose of this filing is to increase the monthly Business Exchange Access Line Service to \$21.00 from the current rates of \$18.00 (16.67%) and \$20.50 (2.4%) respectively. The Public Access Line rate changes with the Business Exchange Access Line Service rate. The Residential Exchange Access Line Service will increase to \$14.00 from its current rate of \$12.00 (16.67%). These changes will be effective May 1, 2013.

The Custom Calling Services will change as follows: Caller Identification Number and Caller Identification Name and Number for business customers will decrease to \$3.00 from the current rates of \$3.95 and \$5.95 respectively. Caller Identification Number and Caller Identification Name and Number for residential customers will increase and decrease to \$3.00 from the current rates of \$2.95 and \$5.95 respectively. Residential Call Detail EAS will increase

to \$10.00 from its current rate of \$7.50. Business and Residential Call Rejection will decrease to \$1.50 from the current rates of \$2.25 and \$2.00 respectively. Simultaneous Ringing will decrease to \$1.50 from its current rate of \$2.25. In addition Last Call Return, Priority Call, Selective Call Acceptance and Selective Call Forwarding for business and residential customers will decrease to \$1.50 from the current rates of \$2.25 and \$2.00 respectively. Telemarketer Call Screening will decrease to \$3.00 from its current rate of \$3.95. Custom Ringing for Preference and Teen Lines will decrease to \$3.00 from the current rates of \$5.00 and \$3.95 respectively. All other features will be combined with a new rate of \$1.50 for both residential and business customers.

This filing creates a Remote Call Forwarding service with a rate of \$25.50. There is also a change to non-recurring charges, combining the Service Order and Line Connection Charges into a single Service Initiation or Change Charge. The PBX Service is combined with Businesses Exchange Access Line Service.

In addition, the EdLINE line rate will be increasing to \$17.50 from its current rate of \$14.50. The Optional Feature monthly rate for Call Handling Enhancement and Call Waiting Enhancement per Line will increase to \$1.50 from the current rates of \$1.25 and \$.85 respectively.

The overall annual revenue effect is an increase of \$33,106 in overall annual revenue.

This filing conforms the Company's tariff to the "urban rate floor" provisions of FCC Order No. 11-161. In the course of that Order, the Federal Communications Commission adopted new rules concerning the universal service program. The effect of those rules is to penalize any company whose residential rate is less than \$14.00 on June 1, 2013. The penalty is a dollar-for-dollar reduction in universal service support for the Company's operations.

In Docket UT-110858, the Company filed financial information concerning its operations. In discussion with Commission Staff, this filing will be based upon the information that the Company has filed in Docket UT-110858.

As a result of using the financial information filed by the Company in Docket UT-110858, the Company is requesting a waiver of the filing requirements of WAC 480-07-160. In addition, the Company requests waiver of the requirement in WAC 480-80-104(7) to state the percentage of increase or decrease in each case due to the large volume of changes.

The Notice to customers is attached and includes additional information concerning the filing. The Notice was mailed to customers prior to the date of this letter.
