Dear Mr. King:

Pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC, please find enclosed for filing the following proposed revision to the WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service of Puget Sound Energy (the “Company” or “PSE”).

- 20th Revision of Sheet No. 51 – LED (Light Emitting Diode) Lighting Service
- 7th Revision of Sheet No. 51-A – LED (Light Emitting Diode) Lighting Service

- 2nd Revision of Sheet No. 51-D – LED (Light Emitting Diode) Lighting Service
(Continued)
- 1st Revision of Sheet No. 51-H – LED (Light Emitting Diode) Lighting Service

The purpose of this filing is to offer the availability of a lighting system under Schedule 51 where PSE finances the installation cost. This offering uses the same methodology that the Company uses to offer financing of lighting systems under Schedule 52.

The rate (Option A) for recovery of the cost of the lighting system is based on the Schedule 52 Option A rate but reduced by the same amount that the Schedule 52 Option B rate was reduced to reflect reduced maintenance costs of LED lighting systems under Schedule 51.


