	FINDINGS AN	D CONCLUSIONS
(1)	The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate public service companies, including household goods moving companies. RCW 80.01.040; Chapter 81.04 RCW; Chapter 81.28 RCW; and Chapter 81.80 RCW.	
(2)	REK Investment is a household goods moving company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.	
(3)	REK Investment is subject to the provisions of RCW 81.04.080 and WAC 480-15-480 requiring household goods moving companies to file an annual report no later than May 1 of each year.	

- 6 (4) WAC 480-15-035(1) provides that the Commission may grant an exemption of any rule in this chapter when doing so is consistent with the public interest.
- 7 (5) This matter was brought before the Commission at it s regularly scheduled meeting on April 24, 2014.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition filed in Docket TV-140582 by REK Investment on April 8, 2014, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is reasonable and should be granted.

## **ORDER**

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The exemption sought by REK Investment, LLC dba Greenway Moving & Delivery for an extension until June 2, 2014, to file its 2013 annual report is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by REK Investment, LLC dba Greenway Moving & Delivery to file its 2013 annual report by June 2, 2014, may result in the Commission invoking provisions of Chapter 81.04 RCW that provide for penalty assessments.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and REK Investment, LLC dba Greenway Moving & Delivery to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
