Dear Commission;

I would like to apologize for my 2013 annual report being late. This has never happened in the past and will certainly not happen again. It was just overlooked. Our water system lost close to 13,000 dollars last year. This penalty will be hard to absorb.

Crescent Bar Inc also operates a golf course, campground, marina and a sewer plant. Having said that, an unforeseen problem has cost us to lose an extreme amount of money for the 2014 season. There is a crack in the Wanapum Dam. The Grant County PUD that operates the dam has lowered the river and has closed all access to the shoreline. All of our campers have cancelled their reservations for the summer and our golf course revenue has been cut in half.

This penalty couldn't have come in a worse time. I would like to ask the Commission to waive the penalty as this is the first and last time this will happen.

RCW 9A.72.020:

“Perjury in the first degree. (1) A person is guilty of perjury in the first degree if in any official proceeding he makes a materially false statement which he knows to be false under an oath required or authorized by law. (2) Knowledge of the materiality of the statement is not an element of this crime, and the actor’s mistaken belief that his statement was not material is not a defense to a prosecution under this section. (3) Perjury in the first degree is a class B felony.”

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
